SATURDAY

- 2 x 20 targets; Course A and Course B
- Courses open as early as you'd like to get out there
- Off the courses by 3.30pm to allow for course adaptations
- Rekon Drone TAC-Style Longshot, 4pm at registration
- Other fun shoots, 5pm at the archery range
- Camp-out potluck at 6.45pm

IMPORTANT!

- For 2-day shooters, scorecards must be handed into the registration table when you come off the course on Saturday.
- Hand them in, bundled in the group you intend to shoot with on Sunday
- Your scorecard bundle will be available to pick up at the registration table on Sunday morning from 7.00am
- You will have been allocated a starting target for Sunday and you must be at your starting target, with your group, ready to shoot when you hear the shotgun at 8.15am
- Day shooters for Sunday-only must also be registered and at their allocated target for the 8.15am shotgun

SUNDAY

- 2 x 20 targets, Course A & Course B
- Shotgun start at 8.15am - Give yourself enough time to get out to your allocated starting target
- Mike Jones Knife & Tool Sponsored Steel Target shoot, 2.30pm at the short range
- Medals, raffles, presentations and any shoot-offs will be at around 3.00pm

SHOOTING STAKES

- ORANGE: Adult compound
- WHITE: Longbow, Instinctive, Barebow, Cadet Compound
- GREEN: Cadet Traditional, All Cubs, All Pre-Cub
- ANYWHERE: Pee-wee's

All non-competitors, move closer if you need.....fun first!

AGES: MASTER 60yrs +, ADULT 18-59yrs, CADET 15-17yrs, CUB 13-14yrs, PRE CUB 10-12yrs, PEE WEE 9yrs & under

EQUIPMENT CATEGORIES

- Longbow (wooden arrows)
- Instinctive ("Traditional" wooden/laminated bow, any arrows, fixed anchor, fingers touching arrow)
- Barebow (Any single string bow including metal target risers, any arrows, face/string-walking)
- Compound Fixed Pins (no rangefinder)
- Compound Unlimited (no rangefinder)
- K50 (rangefinder permitted, see below)

IMPORTANT : Archers shooting without rangefinders cannot shoot with rangefinder archers or scores may not be submitted to leaderboards)

GENERAL

- One arrow per target
- One mulligan per Course A & one mulligan per Course B, per day
- No rangefinders on the practice range
- Be aware of other groups, let quicker/smaller groups "shoot through"
- Don't hold up other groups looking for arrows, return later if needed
- Lost Arrow Bucket available by registration, for any found arrows
- Controlled pets are welcome. Please clean up after them
- NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL ON THE COURSE
- NO CROSSBOWS
- Be respectful if using a generator
