

KTSA GUN & ANTIQUE SHOW RULES

Exhibitors that violate any of these rules may be removed forthwith and/or denied future participation.

- 1.** The Show Committee reserves the right in its sole discretion to accept or reject any application. The Show Committee also reserves the right to request removal of an exhibitor who is disrespectful in any way to anyone. No Exhibitor shall set up a table that is deemed to be unsuitable for this show.
- 2.** All Exhibitors will conduct themselves in a professional and safe manner at all times.
- 3.** All Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws must be observed. All firearms must have bolt removed or a secure locking device installed. All persons acquiring firearms and/or ammunition must be in possession of a valid PAL/POL as required.
- 4.** Let no one handle a firearm in an unsafe manner. Confirm that all firearms are unloaded, locked & secured at all times. No ammunition is to be loaded into a firearm for any reason whatsoever.
- 5.** Black powder is not permitted on the premises. Smokeless powder must be in factory containers.
- 6.** No one will be allowed to leave the premises with merchandise unless accompanied by a written receipt or a KTSA Show sticker. All firearm sales must have a written receipt that you provide showing the description, make, model and serial number(if available).
- 7.** Exhibitors will not alter the floor plan or table layout without the approval of the Show Committee. Display items must not encroach on walkways.
- 8.** Exhibitors and their assistants must wear & clearly display name tags & ribbons at all times.
- 9.** The Exhibitor or an assistant must remain at the table(s) for the duration of the show. Exhibitors who leave before 3pm on Sunday without permission of the Committee will be banned from future shows.
- 10.** Tables are not transferable.
- 11.** No pets of any kind are allowed on McArthur Island, by City of Kamloops By-Law.
- 12.** The use of these facilities, including but not limited to loading and unloading your vehicle, is done at your own risk. Neither the Show Committee, the Kamloops Target Sports Association, nor the City of Kamloops are liable to any Exhibitor, his partners, helpers, or guests for any damage whatsoever, including but not limited to damage to a vehicle or any part or attachment to it. The driver and/or owner of any vehicle and the Exhibitor are jointly and severally liable for any Personal Injury, damage to the building or the contents thereof, damage to exhibits, or any other damage whatsoever.
- 13.** If the Exhibitor must cancel their participation in the show, they are required to notify the Show Committee as soon as possible. Refunds are available for cancellations more than 14 days prior to the show. Exhibitors who fail to attend the Show without notice may be barred from exhibiting at future shows.

1. Applications are processed on a first come, first served basis. An application will not be processed unless accompanied by payment in full. Exhibitors who renew on the Sunday of the current year's show are guaranteed their same location for next year if desired.
2. Exhibitor packages will be waiting for you at the show. They do not get mailed out.
3. All Exhibitor packages include 2 ribbons. Additional ribbons can be purchased at the show for \$15 each.
4. Confirmation of booking is only provided upon request accompanied with a self addressed stamped envelope. Please check the arena maps at <https://ktsa.ca/gunshow/vendor-information/> to confirm your tables. We will update the website twice a month or as volume of applications dictates.
5. NSF cheques will reduce the odds of your attendance at future shows.
6. Setup is Friday from 12 noon to 8pm. No vehicles are allowed in the buildings. Arenas A & B will have pallets & pallet movers available to assist you. Please bring your own dollies/carts if possible. Arena C is self load in/out.
7. No setup on Saturday morning is allowed unless previously authorized. If authorized, setup must be complete before the show opens to the public.
8. The show is open to the public from 9am-5pm Saturday, and 9am-3pm Sunday.
9. Provide your own table covers capable of reaching the floor under your table, keeping material stored under the table out of sight. Bring additional covers to cover everything before and after show times.
10. Chairs are not guaranteed. It is **STRONGLY** recommended that you provide your own.
11. KTSA provides professional security on site 24 hours a day for the duration of the Show.
12. On Sunday at 3pm, Exhibitors will pack their goods without blocking the walkways. The building must be cleared by no later than 6pm. Vehicles will be allowed in the loading area only when goods are waiting to be loaded.
13. Exhibitors from Vancouver Island are urged to reserve a berth on the 9pm ferry. Do not depend on catching the 7pm ferry.
14. Overnight parking for recreation vehicles in the designated parking lot is available from the City at \$15.00 per night
